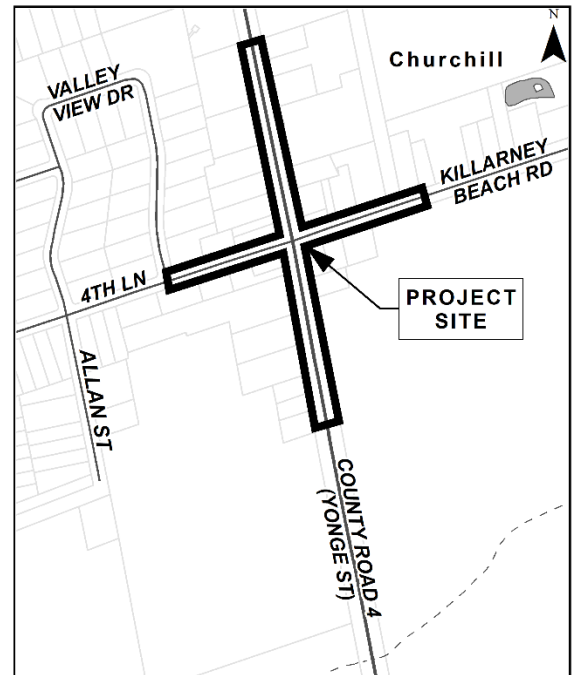


Notice of Project and Public Open House Municipal Class Environmental Assessment County Road 4 and Innisfil 4th Line Intersection Improvements

The Project

The County of Simcoe is planning to reconstruct the intersection of County Road 4 (Yonge Street), Innisfil 4th Line and Killarney Beach Road. Reconstruction will include improvements to intersection safety, traffic control and active transportation; as well as upgrades to the existing storm sewer, retaining walls and concrete stairs.

Widening of the roads within the project site is necessary to accommodate increased traffic volumes, provide improved traffic flow through Churchill and maintain connections to Highway 400 via County Road 89 and County Road 21 (Innisfil Beach Road).



The project will follow Schedule A+ of the Municipal Class Environmental Assessment process (Municipal Engineers Association, October 2000, as amended in 2007, 2011, 2015), which is a pre-approved process under the *Ontario Environmental Assessment Act*.

Starting February 3, 2022, there will be Virtual Public Open House information materials posted on the County website. The Virtual Public Open House will describe the project and provide residents with an opportunity to review construction plans and schedules.
